

Blind & Partially Sighted Dragon Boating 2017

A dragon boat is a 40 foot long boat, with 20 benches. Two paddlers sit on each bench, one on the left, and one on the right. It is a flat bottomed very stable boat. There is a coach/steersperson standing in the back.

Sessions are open to you and a guide. We would like to have a one to one ratio of sighted and non-sighted paddlers, so we are happy to provide a bench mate for you but would ask that you please let us know in advance that you will be coming and need a partner.

- Wear clothing and footwear that can get wet, preferably in layers so you can adjust.
- If you have a service dog, we can arrange for a dog watcher if you let us know in advance.
- We do not cancel in inclement weather, with the exception of lightning.
